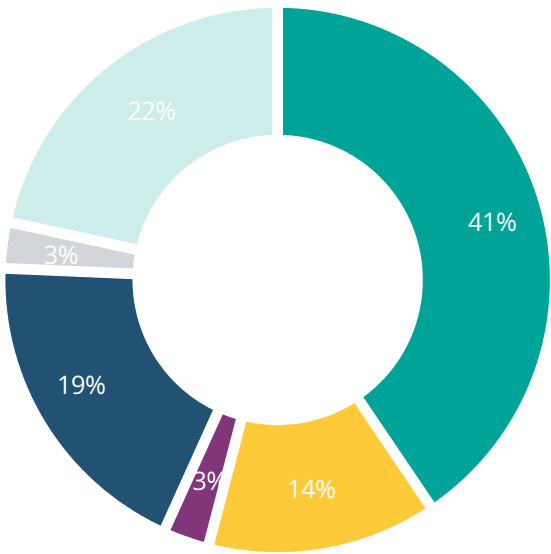

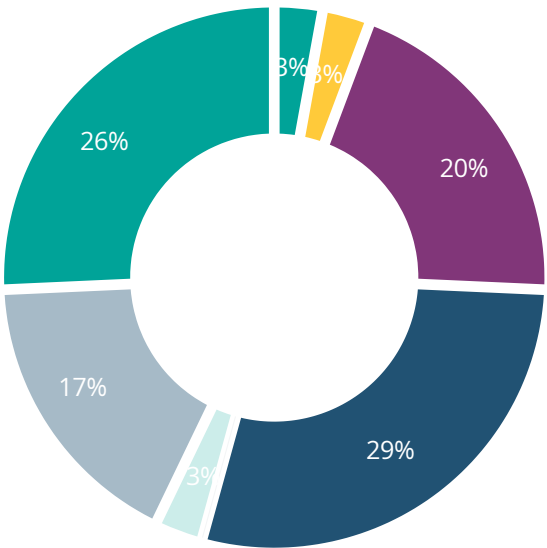

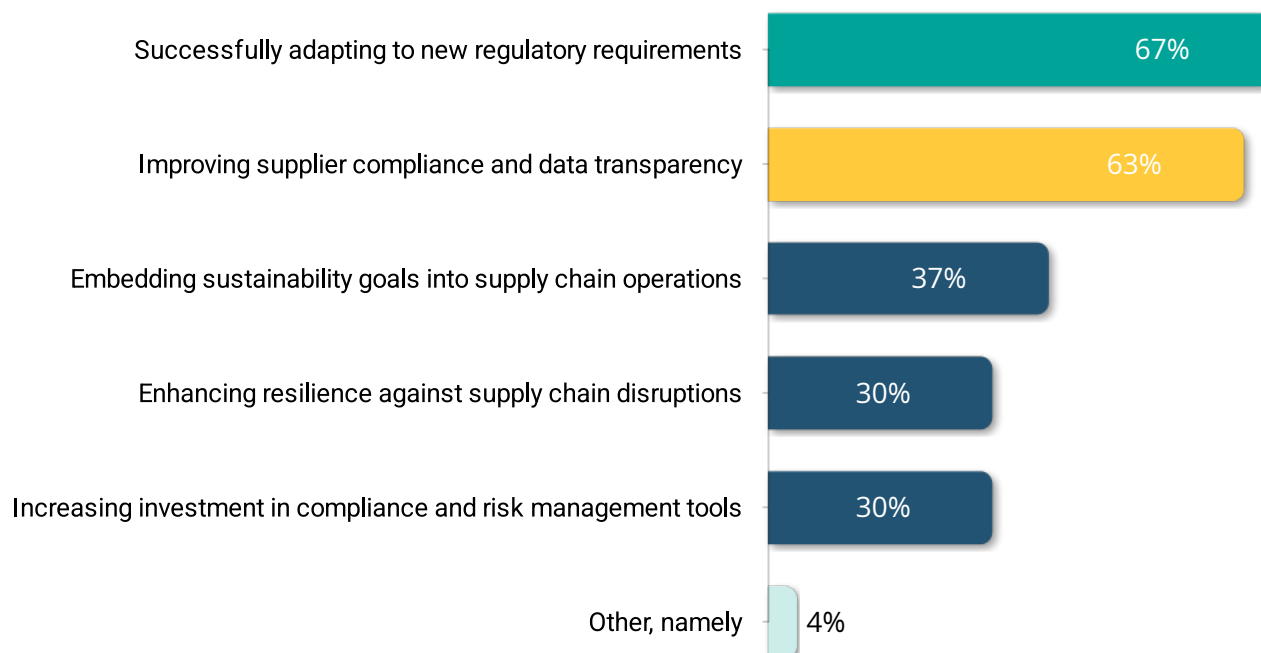

A company's supply chain structure and governance determine its ability to manage risks and drive efficiency. This section examines your organization's supply chain maturity, accountability, and supplier relationships.

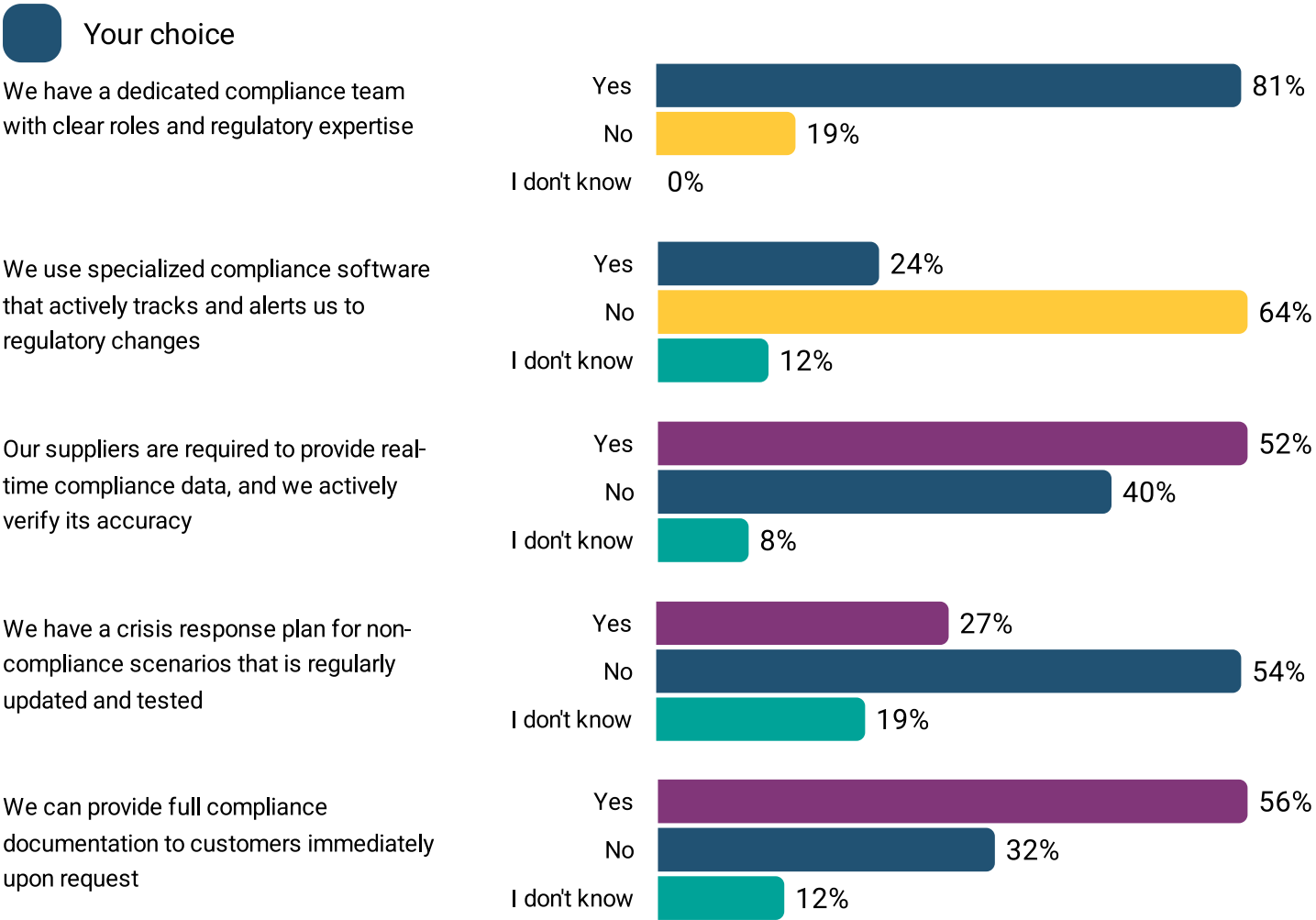

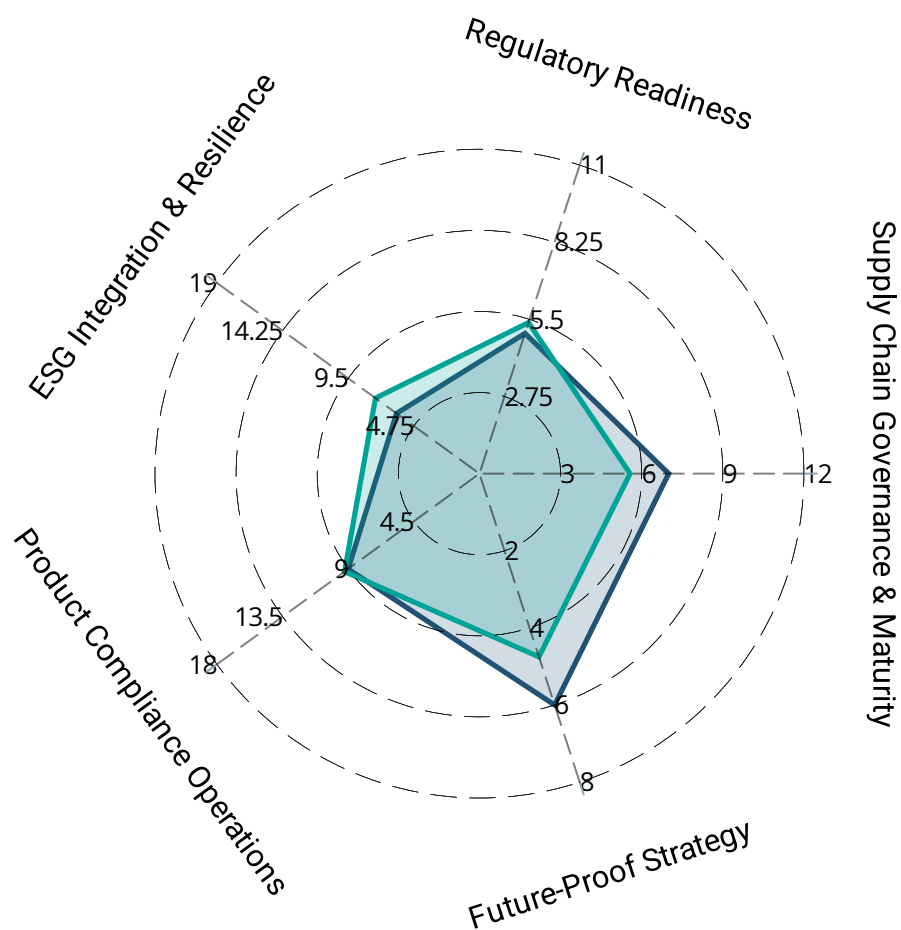
